HPC's Vision Statement

Executive summary and recommendations

Introduction

Following on from previous discussions, the meeting of Council at the October Away Day agreed that the Health Professions Council (HPC) adopt a Vision Statement. This Statement should concur with the objectives, values and strategy of the organisation.

The purpose of the Vision Statement is to define where the HPC wants to be in the future. Features of an effective Vision Statement may include:

- Clarity and lack of ambiguity •
- Alignment with the organisational values and culture •
- Aspirational and achievable

It is proposed that the Statement should be:

"The Health Professions Council aims to be recognised internationally as a model of best practice in the regulation of health professionals."

It was also recommended that the Vision Statement should be reviewed periodically.
