

Health Professions Council – 3 July 2008

Appointment of new members following the 2008 election

Executive summary and recommendations

Introduction

Rule 11 (4) of the Health Professions Council Election Scheme Rules provides that when the Returning Officer declares the result of the Council elections he shall present a certificate of the results to Council at their next meeting.

Rule 12(1) states that 'the Council, upon receipt of the Returning Officer's certificate shall, where the Returning Officer certifies that the home country representation requirement would be met, appoint the persons elected as registrant members and alternate members of the Council'.

The ballots for the 2008 elections in the Operating Department and Clinical Scientist constituencies will close on Friday 27 June 2008. The candidates in the Dietitians and Speech and Language Therapy constituencies were elected unopposed.

The Returning Officer's certificate which lists the results of the elections will be tabled at 3 July 2008 Council meeting. There is no home country requirement to be met in these elections.
