Introduction

The Appointments Commission has completed the process to recruit two lay members to the lay vacancies on the Council. An offer was made to one candidate however the candidate was also offered another non-executive role and as a consequence felt unable to commit sufficient time to HPC. No offer was made in respect of the other vacancy.

The recruitment exercise for the restructured Council is likely to start in autumn 2008. It is therefore proposed that the two lay vacancies should not be filled.
