## Introduction

On 16 June 2008 the 'Report to Ministers from the Department of Health Steering Group on the Statutory Regulation of Practitioners of Acupuncture, Herbal Medicine, Traditional Chinese Medicine and Other Traditional Medicine Systems Practised in the UK' was published.

The report recommends that acupuncturists, herbalists and traditional Chinese medicine practitioners should become regulated by the HPC.
