Final report of the Returning Officer

I, Marc Seale, as Returning Officer for the elections held on Friday 27 June 2008 HEREBY REPORT that:

- 1. I presented a certificate of the results of those elections to the Council on 3 July 2008 in accordance with Rule 11(4) of the Health Professions Council (Election Scheme) Rules 2004 ('the Election Rules') and that I have not, within the 28 day period from that date prescribed by Rule 16(1) of the Election Rules, received any protest in the form prescribed by that Rule as to the outcome of any of the elections.
