Issues of Relevance to HPC

This is a significant day in the NHS Wales calendar which is co-hosted by the Welsh NHS Confederation, Welsh Government and NLIAH (National Leadership and Innovation Agency). The day recognised good practice within the NHS and provided learning material to support the training and development of NHS Staff in Wales. The shortlisted entries for the award appear on Goodpracticewales.com. Key note speakers included the Minister for Health and Social Services and Director General Health and Social Services.

Apart from the Awards ceremony there was opportunity for delegates to attend workshops led by representatives of the shortlisted submissions. One that I attended involved the category: 'Citizens at the centre of service redesign and delivery. Specifically, this had a presentation and discussion on 'Promoting best practice and meaningful service user participation in Health Professional Training'. The project chosen involved Psychologist training where it had achieved approval from HPC in 2010.

As such issues such as those of prescribing rights are often discussed at these meetings.

Issues of Relevance to HCPC		
This informal meeting was requested by the President and CEO of IBMS to discuss changes within the regulatory processes, being consulted upon, impacting Biomedical Scientists.		
The following topics were discussed:		
1. Modernising Scientific Careers. As per DOH policy IBMS has developed and implemented new training programmes and introduced two new staff groups to IBMS membership register (from July 2012) - Registered Science Technician (RSciTech) and Registered Scientist (RSci). These positions are approved (under licence) by Science Council for practitioners in Science. They will fit within afc band 2-4. IBMS agreed that further work is required to remove confusion in the use of the word 'registered'.		
 2. HCPC register for voluntary registration I confirmed that this subject is currently being discussed in Council – no decision has been taken. The following issues are under consideration: a. relationship with statutory regulation b. enforcement on FTP/witness call c. finance d. CHRE (PSA) 		
3. HCPC standards of Proficiency for BMS Consultation on this document will commence in 2013. IBMS suggested that they may wish to bounce 'ideas' informally with me.

IBMS have asked me to join their council meetings to exchange relevant information which would assist collaborative working on projects e.g. modernising scientific careers; standards of proficiency, etc
