The training was in two parts – Financial Reporting Update and Governance. There was a healthy amount of participant involvement in both sessions.

Financial Reporting Update:

We started on the FRC's recent document that confirms that the "true and fair" requirement remains – "fair presentation" under IFRS is equivalent to true and fair. A very interesting session.

We moved on to IFRS 15 – Revenue from Contracts with Customers. This is very complicated and will have a major impact on income reporting for certain types of businesses. I do not see it having any impact on HCPC, but I am sure NAO will advise if it does, but in any event it does not become live for a few years.

We then went on to the current status of accounting for leases – again very interesting. There were a few other sundry accounting updates.

Governance:

This was really good. We covered Narrative Reporting, Audit Committees' and Auditors' Reports, changes to the UK Corporate Governance Code and finished with EC Audit Reform.
