Anti-Bribery Policy (report ref:- HCPC59/14)  Executive to report to the May meeting of Council on the roles which require criminal records checks within the HCPC (19.3)	Executive	The HCPC uses the Disclosure and Barring Service (DBS) to assess the suitability of applicants for roles which involve access to children and vulnerable adults. Currently this applies to roles within the Fitness to Practise department only.  Applicants for roles in any other department of the HCPC will not normally be subject to a DBS check. However all applicants are asked to declare on the HCPC's recruitment application form whether they have any 'unspent' convictions under the Rehabilitation of Offenders Act 1974.
