Generic standards of proficiency

Executive summary and recommendations

#### Introduction

At its meeting on 4 December 2007, the Education and Training Committee considered a paper from the Executive about the generic standards of proficiency.

The Committee agreed that a paper should be brought back to a future Committee meeting about reviewing the generic standards of proficiency, in light of the discussion of the Professional Liaison Group (PLG) which put together draft standards of proficiency for practitioner psychologists.

The consultation on standards of proficiency for practitioner psychologists closed on 8 February 2008. The consultation responses are currently being analysed.

A paper regarding the possible review of the generic standards of proficiency, in light of the consultation responses received, will be brought back to the committee at its meeting in June.

#### **Decision**

### **Background information**

• The consultation on the threshold level of qualification for entry to the registered psychologists part of the Register closed on 8 February 2008. The responses to the consultations will be considered by the Committee at a future meeting, dependent upon the legislative timetable for the regulation of practitioner psychologists. It is presently anticipated that the Education and Training Committee will consider the responses at its meeting on 25 September 2008.
