Annotation of the Register – qualifications in podiatric surgery

Executive summary and recommendations

Introduction

At its meeting on 10 May 2012, the Council, following a recommendation from the Education and Training Committee, decided that we should annotate qualifications in podiatric surgery on our Register. The qualification is currently the Certificate of Completion in Podiatric Surgical Training, although work is taking place in Scotland to develop a comparable qualification delivering training in podiatric surgery practice as well.

We continue with work to develop the standards for podiatric surgery and to engage with stakeholders in this area. We will provide a more detailed update on our work in this area at a future meeting.
