in respect of the condition on standard 4.2, the wording should be amended for clarity to

whilst that condition is to apply, the Panel accepts that the reasoning for the condition needs to be expanded. The Panel direct the executive to include an additional sentence in the reasoning of this condition referencing the practice placement resource requirements for the 2018-19 academic year in addition to the academic resource requirements in the 2019-20 academic year.
