The Standards of Conduct, Performance and Ethics (SCPE) state that a registrant must provide any important information about conduct, competence or health. Registrant's must inform the HPC when they are

- convicted of a criminal offence (other than a motoring offence) or accept a police caution;
- disciplined by any organization responsible for regulating or licensing a health or social care profession; or
- suspended or placed under a practice restriction by an employer or similar organisation because of concerns about your conduct or competence
