

Supporting advanced levels of practice: roles across the system



Registrant

- Work within your individual scope of practice
- Meet standards set by the regulator relevant to your scope of practice
- Undertake continuing professional development (CPD) and record its outcome and impact, to benefit the people you serve
- Maintain registration, including arrangements for professional indemnity



Regulator

- Set and uphold standards to protect the public
- Manage concerns relating to registrants' fitness to practise
- Quality assure pre-registration education and training programmes
- Maintain a register of those allowed to practise in the UK
- Provide evidence-based, data-informed guidance and support



Employing organisation

- Provide clear leadership structures
- Develop, implement and review workforce policies and processes for advanced levels of practice
- Engage in workforce planning to support career development for advanced levels of practice, to meet service user needs
- Provide registrants with support to meet regulatory requirements
- Provide clear governance and leadership oversight



Professional body

- Provide profession-specific guidance and standards
- Create networking and other CPD opportunities for members seeking to advance their practice
- Advocate for advanced levels of practice relevant to the individual profession
- Support and promote research
- Provide support and guidance to make the most of an individual's scope of practice and for the broader profession
